PRESIDENTIAL VISIT - Advance Notice. We have been invited to host a 'Visit of the Methodist President of Conference Service' on October 18th 2015 at Bude Methodist Church. The President Elect, to take office in September, is our old friend Rev Steve Wild, currently Chair of the Cornwall District.



As we expect that invitations will be extended to other local churches of all denominations, including those in neighbouring circuits and into the Cornwall District, the service will be later than usual, starting at 11am to facilitate travelling.

Arrangements will be finalised in due course, but the service is likely to be followed by a Bring and Share Lunch, giving us the opportunity for conversation with the President.

This Sunday will be the Bible Christian bi-centenary. The Bible Christian Church was a Methodist denomination founded by William O'Bryan, a Wesleyan Methodist local preacher, on 18th October 1815 in North Cornwall, with the first society, just 22 members, meeting at Lake Farm in Shebbear, Devon, and became a major denomination in Devon and Cornwall.
